Hjalteyri is one of North Iceland's best kept secrets. Located only 15 minutes from Akureyri, the charming fishing village is extremely peaceful and relaxed. From there, you will depart on a traditional Icelandic oak boat towards traditional whale watching areas in Iceland's longest fjord. In the last two years, we have had a 100% sightings rate in Hjalteyri. Once back to shore, we will explore the old monumental herring factory, which is now used as a venue for art exhibitions, and taste fresh delicacies served by local chef from Eyri Restaurant. If you're feeling adventurous, take a dip in the outdoor hot tub down by the black sand beach.
